### Family Care Ministry

Provides emergency food and other assistance to families going through difficult times.

### Men's Ministry

Offers temporary shelter to homeless men seeking to gain housing and employment; Offers Christ-centered residential life/addiction recovery and discipleship programs; serves one meal 365 days a year that is open to anyone who has a need.

### Covenant House Ministry

A safe, temporary (30-day) shelter for homeless women and families where they can heal, think, pray and plan.

### Aftercare Ministry

Provides follow-up mentoring as clients transition out of Mission programs; trains local churches to do the same.

### Youth Ministry at Sankey Center

Structured after-school and summer programs offering educational, recreational, and spiritual activities for youth.
