

JESUS FIRST: A RECOVERY PROGRAM FOR WOMEN

For women who wish to make a long term commitment to breaking the bonds of strongholds and addiction, there is the Jesus First Program. Jesus First is a long term Biblical discipleship program for women



to focus on healing and recovering from their past through devotions, Bible studies, classes and spiritual guidance. Upon graduation from the program, guests will learn that through a relationship with Jesus Christ, they can leave their troubled past and start anew with hope for the future.

How much does it cost to enter the Jesus First Program?

There is no cost to the program participants as generous friends of the Mission provide the financial support for all of its services.

How long does it take to finish the Jesus First Program?

Each participant progresses through each phase of the program at her own pace. On average, it takes up to one year to complete the program.

Will I stay at the Mission if I join the Jesus First Program?

Yes, program participants can stay at Hope Place, where they are assigned a personal room for themselves.

Will I have to buy my own food and cook my meals?

Yes, Hope Place has a full kitchen with multiple appliances for guests to cook and prepare meals each day.

Will I have to attend devotions and Bible study each day?

Yes, because we know a relationship with Jesus Christ is the only proven way of success and freedom from any bondage.
