Safe Shelter at Hope Place

Hope Place is the name of the Mission's shelter for women and women with children who seek temporary shelter or long term stay through the Jesus First program. The shelter has all the comforts of a home, where guests each have a bed and share a common living area along with a kitchen to prepare meals. Volunteers often visit to host Bible studies, meals, and special activities or parties for guests.



Children Friendly

Women with children will find comfort in knowing their children are safe at Hope Place. The shelter has a playground with equipment children of all ages can enjoy.
