#### THE RECOVERY PROGRAM

The Men's Ministry Recovery Program is a biblicallybased, residential discipleship program which teaches a way to conquer and overcome life issues. Our caring and compassionate staff and volunteers offer classes covering many issues men face when dealing with addictions and other life bondage issues. Each man joining the RecoveryProgram has the opportunity to gain support from others who have gone through much of the same suffering. In addition to structured study and biblical discipleship, men will have the opportunity to take advantage of the reading library, television lounge, and recreation room equipped with pool and ping-pong tables along with exercise equipment. **If you are interested in joining, call 724-652-4321.** 



#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### How much does it cost to enter the Recovery Program?

There is no cost to the program participants as generous friends of the Mission provide the financial support for all of its services.

# How long does it take to finish the Recovery Program?

Each participant progresses through the five phases of the program at his own pace. On average, it takes about a year to finish all five phases.

## Will I stay at the Mission if I join the Recovery Program?

Yes, program participants are assigned a bed in the Recovery Program dormitory .

#### Will I have to buy my own food and cook my meals?

No, the Mission provides breakfast, lunch, and dinner each day.

## Will I have to attend Chapel and study the Bible each day?

Yes, because we know a relationship with Jesus Christ is the only proven way of success and freedom from any bondage.
